Documents needed for screening of food stamps and general assistance are listed below. Please bring copies of documents. If you do not have the necessary documents, the case worker can help you obtain them. If you are a senior citizen or disabled we can arrange for a home visit with a case worker.

You must have documents to verify:

Identity:

Birth certificates
Social Security cards
Alien Registration, Passport, Visa

Marital/dependent status:

Marriage Certificate
Divorce Decree
Death Certificate of spouse
Custody papers
School attendance verification for children
If pregnant - Doctor's slip with expected due date

Residence:

Gas, electric and/or fuel oil bill
Telephone bill
Rent receipts/lease
Letter from a cash paid landlord
Letter from a shelter where you are registered

Income and additional resources:

Pay or disability stubs
Pension
W2
Child support
Social Security or SSI award letter
NJ Unemployment award letter
